

Film Making HNC (Higher National Certificate)

Level 4 - equivalent to the first year of a degree

This is the film school's flagship course and will cover every aspect of film making, direction and production. Students will be taught by a range of guest lecturers including Brian Tufano (acclaimed Cinematographer, whose credits include Trainspotting, Billy Elliot, Shallow Grave, Quadrophenia, East Is East, Kidulthood). Students will work to create a portfolio of work covering the units listed below.

Students can progress to the Film School's HND (Higher National Diploma) equivalent to the second year of a degree.

Acceptance onto this course is by interview and you should already have a level 3 qualification, or can demonstrate relevant work experience.

Units and assignments

Contextual Studies

Understand how the Film and TV industry is structured, the role of distribution, exhibition, new media and audience response.

Research Techniques

Understand the importance of research in the Film and TV industry, whether it is as a researcher working with a broadcaster, arranging for music copyright clearance, photographs, archive material or locating contributors for programming.

Practical Skills

Introduction to Film and HD cameras, sound recording equipment, pre-production, production and post-production skills developed through practical film making.

Film Studies

Understanding of film language and grammar, sound in film, lighting and editing techniques through the study and analysis of independent and studio produced films.

Camera and Lighting

Understand lenses, film formats (Super-8, 16mm, 35mm) Video formats (SD, HDV, HD), lighting (Arris, Red heads, Blondes, Kino Flow, dado) three point lighting technique.
